

COOKIE POLICY

DEFINITION OF COOKIES

A cookie is a small piece of data (text file) that the website - when visited by a user - asks your browser to install in order to store information about you and your browsing, such as your language preference or login information. These cookies are set by us and are called first-party cookies.

More specifically, we use cookies and other tracking technologies for the following purposes:

- Certification that the Website is functioning correctly;
- Storage of User preferences, such as the selected language and font size;
- Discover the details of the User's browsing experience;

The use of cookies and similar technologies allows us to ensure that the Website is accessed, operated and adapted to the preferences of Users and third parties so that they function correctly, as well as to personalise content and advertisements based on browsing habits.

COOKIES REQUIRED

These cookies are used to activate essential website functions that cannot be deactivated on **PSA's** systems. As a rule, these cookies are only installed in response to actions carried out by Users, corresponding to a service request, such as logging onto the Website pages, setting privacy preferences or filling in forms. The deactivation and blocking of this type of cookies may be carried out directly in the User's browser. However, access to the Website may be blocked by the **PSA** or some pages of the Website may not work. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.
